# <u>RESOLUTION # 32/2007 MORATORIUM/VARIANCE REQUEST 800</u> <u>CLOCKTOWER COMMONS</u>

Introduced By: Councilman Honeck Seconded By: Councilwoman Mitts

**WHEREAS**, on February 28, 2002 this Town Board adopted Local Law No. 1 of 2002, which imposed a moratorium on certain residential subdivision and commercial projects in specified areas of the Town of Southeast; and

July 12, 2007

**WHEREAS**, said local law has been amended and extended and remains in full force and effect with regard to commercially zoned properties in specified areas of the Town; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV of said Local Law, Clock Tower Associates, L.P. and Royal Realty Corp. (the "Applicant") have filed a written request for relief from the restriction of such moratorium in connection with the proposed construction of an additional free standing building within the commercial development known as Clock Tower Commons, in an area known as 800 Clock Tower Commons (the "Premises");and

**WHEREAS,** the Applicant, has appeared before the Town board and presented arguments in support of its request for a variance to allow the addition of an additional office building within the Clock Tower Commons facility while the moratorium remains in effect; and

**WHEREAS,** a duly noticed public hearing was held by this Town Board on July 12, 2007 to consider the application for relief from the moratorium.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board finds and determines, that the proposed new construction is located within an existing commercial development; that the proposed new building will be used for office purposes, the same use that is presently employed in the majority of the Clock Tower Commons; that the proposed new construction is in keeping with the Comprehensive Plan; and that, based upon submissions dated March 20, 2007, April 5. 2007, May 9, 2007 and June 4, 2007, the Board is satisfied that substantial evidence exists to support a finding of real financial hardship if the waiver to the moratorium were not granted; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that based upon the foregoing findings of fact, the application for a variance or waiver of the provision of Local Law NO. 1 of 2002 by Clock Tower Associates, L.P., is hereby GRANTED and, therefore, the applicant shall hereby be permitted to prosecute a project development plan application for the Premises notwithstanding the prohibitions contained Local Law NO. 1 of 2002 as amended; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of the Planning Board, the Building Inspector and the Zoning Enforcement Officer forthwith.

**WHEREAS**, a resolution having been adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Southeast for a public hearing to be held by said Town Board to hear all interested parties on a proposed local law to amend Chapter 138 of the Southeast Town Code entitled "Zoning", and

**WHEREAS**, notice of said public hearing was advertised in an official newspaper of the Town of Southeast in the manner prescribed by law and such public hearing was held on April19, 2007; and

**WHEREAS,** notice of such proposed amendments to the Zoning Code of the Town of Southeast, including the text thereof, was duly submitted to the Putnam County Planning agency in compliance with Section 239-m of the General Municipal Law and such agency has reviewed same and provided comments and recommendations in connection therewith; and

**WHEREAS**, this Town Board acting as Lead Agency pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act has analyzed the environmental and related impacts of the proposed amendments and have, this date, issued a Negative Declaration of Environmental Significance in connection with this action; and

**WHEREAS,** it is the sense of this Town Board that the adoption of the proposed amendments to Chapter 138 of the Code of the Town of Southeast will further enhance the health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Town of Southeast.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Town Board of the Town of Southeast hereby adopts Local Law No. 4 of 2007, amending Chapter 138 of the Southeast Town Code, a copy of which is annexed hereto and made a part of this resolution, and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and in the Code Book of the Town of Southeast, and to give due notice of the adoption of said local law to the Secretary of State of New York within the time required by law.
